Description	IL-12B (Interleukin-12B) is a crucial cytokine involved in the regulation of
	immune responses. It is primarily produced by immune cells such as macrophages
	and dendritic cells. IL-12B forms a part of the heterodimeric cytokine IL-12,
	which plays a key role in promoting the activation of T cells and natural killer
	(NK) cells, thereby enhancing the body's ability to fight infections and tumors.
	The IL-12B gene encodes the p40 subunit, which combines with the p35 subunit

The IL-12B gene encodes the p40 subunit, which combines with the p35 subunit (encoded by IL-12A) to form active IL-12. Besides its immune-stimulating functions, IL-12B is also involved in inflammation regulation and immune-related diseases. Variations or dysregulation of IL-12B have been linked to various autoimmune and inflammatory conditions, making it an important target for immunotherapy research.



SDS-PAGE



On SDS-PAGE under reducing (R) condition. The gel was stained overnight with Coomassie Blue. The purity of the protein is greater than 90%.
